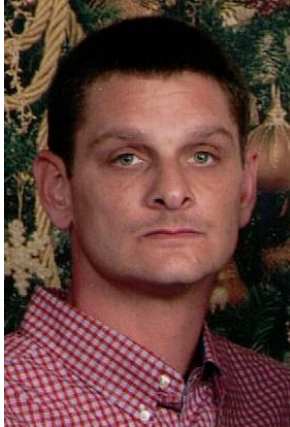


Most Valuable Employee... Employee Appreciation.... September 2011
